FEAST OF OUR LADY OF MOUNT CARMEL

For me the title, Our Lady of Mount Carmel Coorparoo, has a beautiful resonance. And I hope that for all of you, it evokes images of our special community and Mary our patron.

Remember the first time you ever came to Mass at Mount Carmel, and the day when you were married here, and the day when you first child was baptised or made first Holy Communion. Remember the sad day when you said goodbye to your loved one.

The timbered walls enfolding us like a tent, the soft greenery outside the windows, the sculpture beyond the altar of Mary of Carmel giving the scapular to Simon Stock in a gesture of love, have become part of our psyche.

When we sit in the church we know that somewhere there is a friend or two or three. There are the musicians, the singers, the reader going up to read for the first time, concealing so well his or her nervousness, the seven men and women who go forward from every corner to distribute the Body and Blood of the Lord.

Call it atmosphere. Call it ambience. This is a place of community, of friendliness and of prayer.

And of course there is Our Lady of Mount Carmel school. Many of you went to that school. Perhaps you still have friends from those days. Many of you have children and grandchildren there at this very moment. So many stories. So much to share.

Eight hundred years ago the first Carmelites formed a community on Mount Carmel in Palestine. They chose Mary as their companion and sister. They called her The Lady of Carmel. In 1937 parishioners of the new parish of Coorparoo made the same choice. She is still patron for all of us who make up Mount Carmel community today.
