The Ascension of the Lord (Year B)

The theme in today's readings speak strongly to the ideas of continuing the work of God through grace from the Holy Spirit, a theme that will be further developed in next Sunday's celebration of Pentecost.

The Ascension of Jesus into Heaven is in one sense the end of his time here on Earth but in many ways signals the start of his work through the disciples. "Go out to the whole world and proclaim the Good News to all creation" Jesus asks his disciples. A call to action, a call to evangelisation.

Put simply he's saying "It's up to you now".

The message of Jesus in the Gospel and of Paul and Luke in the readings encourages us to take ownership of Jesus call to action, through the power of the Holy Spirit and blessed by the grace of God.

For me it's like the pep talk the coach gives at half time finishing off with the words "it's up to you now" or the advice my parents gave me when I left home to start a new job interstate. The reminder that it was now up to me to make the most of my own life through the choices I made and consequences of those choices.

These themes of change, renewal and personal responsibility resonate strongly with where we're at as Church today. Much has been written about the impact of the Royal Commission into Institutional Responses to Child Sexual Abuse on the Catholic Church and other organisations. It's up to us now as a church to start afresh and proclaim the work of the Holy Spirit into our church.

In our community issues like cyberbullying, domestic and family violence are currently being played out in public discourse. As Catholics we can take up the call to action by reflecting on what would Jesus ask us to do? For each of us this may be something different. Pray about it and ask the Holy Spirit to guide your actions. It is up to us now to make the Kingdom of God a reality.
