The Most **Holy Trinity** (Year A)

Today's readings are a brief but powerful capturing of the sense of God as an outreaching communion of love. There could be no clearer expression of the absolute continuity between the loving act of Christ, God's attitude toward human beings and the experience of the Spirit, the foundation of unity, than in today's readings. The special insight into God we hear today is that relationships are at the very centre of who God is.

The celebration of the Holy Trinity can become tangled up in language that begins to sound mathematical, three in one, one in three, as we try to put words on an unfathomable mystery of the inner life of God: a life we could never have imagined - except that as Christians we have experienced this dynamic and living relationship.

Pope Francis tells us that the "Holy Trinity invites us to engage in daily events to be the leaven of communion, of consolation and of mercy". He goes on to remind us that "we are called to live not without each other, over or against the other, but with one another, and in one another."

As Catholics, we believe that the God who creates, redeems and sustains the world seeks us out and invites us into a loving relationship. This is what gives us our greatest dignity and urges us on to share this message with everyone we meet.

What a privilege!

What an invitation!

What a God!


