The Ascension of the Lord (Year A)

God gave his only son so that we might have Eternal Life.

In the first chapter of Matthew's Gospel, an angel announced that a child will be born and that he will save his people from their sins. That child was Jesus. Today, forty days after the Resurrection, we hear of Jesus' ascension into heaven, back to His Father. The mantel of responsibility to continue to spread the values of Jesus fell to His disciples.

Today, as disciples, our mission is to act and speak for a kingdom of peace, inclusivity, joy, love and right relations. St Teresa of Avila expressed this beautifully, "Christ has no body now but yours. No hands, no feet on earth but yours. Yours are the eyes through which He looks compassion on this world. Yours are the feet with which He walks to do good. Yours are the hands through which He blesses all the world. Yours are the hands, yours are the feet, yours are the eyes, you are His Body. Christ has no body now on earth but yours."

A simple prayer with enormous ambition. It seems straightforward, but is it? How do we find God in all people, in conflict, in resistance, in war, in sin? This is not easy. Sometimes in our frenetic world, we find it hard to find the time to consider God at all, let alone in the dark and difficult spaces. We must try.
