The gospels of recent weeks, the woman at the well, the curing of the blind man and today's story of Jesus raising his dear friend Lazarus have a theological depth - Jesus moving towards the finale of the great mystery of salvation but there is also the insight for us into a loving and caring human being.

As we journey through Lent we can personally be drawn inwards — to who I have become and who I might become. The loving, caring Jesus challenges us to move our focus from ourselves to our community. Unbind what holds us back from reaching out to our neighbour, our community.

We have a part to play in helping one another be unbound and emerge into the light of new life. We saw this image last week in the healing of man born blind. We saw it in the woman at the well, as she took her rightful position in her community.

Fullness of life exists when our lives are shaped by love: when centred on the others and not ourselves; when we give joy to all whom we touch; when our patience, acceptance and kindness go beyond our kind to those who are different, when we listen to people and help them find their voices to speak their truth.

The gospel is about life by building relationships and a better and transformed world for all.
